



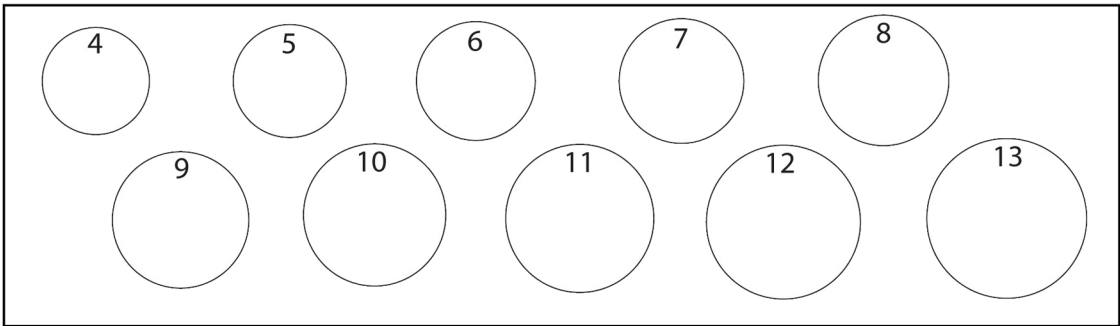
HANDY RING SIZER

BE SURE TO UNCHECK ALL "SCALE TO FIT" BOXES WHEN PRINTING!

We want your gift to be perfect. Getting ring size right can be a challenge, but we can help. This handy ring sizer offers three methods for figuring out the correct ring size. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact us at tlc@turtleloveco.com.

{ 1. MEASURE AN EXISTING RING }

Use a ring from the individual's current jewelry collection. Place the ring on the circles below. The correct circle size will fit right against the **inside** edge of the ring.



{ 2. MEASURE FINGER WITH STRING }

Measure your finger by wrapping a string (make sure it's not stretchy) around the thickest part of your finger (which may be the knuckle). Find the length that makes exactly one loop around, and use the chart below to match the string length to the correct ring size.

{ 3. HANDY CUT-OUT RING SIZER }

Cut out the ring sizer below, and cut a small slit exactly where indicated. Slip the pointed end through the slit, with the numbers facing out. Place the ring sizer comfortably around the thickest part of the finger (which may be the knuckle). Secure the ring sizer so that it's tight but can still move around (a piece of tape can help secure the paper ring). Your ring size should be the number that appears near the arrow.
